Robotics Competition

On Saturday the 19 November, **Lucas Ottley, Mary Hyland and myself (William Hyland)** all competed in the Canberra/ Goulburn robotics scrimmage. When competing in robotics you need to design a robot for a special challenge. This year the challenge is called Crossover. We need to drive and program our robot to pick up Hexballs, put the Hexballs on towers and drive over a see-saw bridge. We also need to write an engineering book which Mary has been in charge of. Lucas and I are the main drivers and Mary is the main programmer. We also had to do an interview where we spoke about our robot and engineering book.

At the end of the day we came first overall which meant we got the Excellence Award.

On the 3 December we are going to Wangaratta in Victoria to compete at the National VEX Robotics championship. We have to also present a project on technology at the Nationals. Our topic is about 3D printing and using Tinkercad to design our own tool. We are also looking at printing hands for children that were born without a hand.

Our robot team is called the Wollondilly Robots and Lucas designed our logo. Hopefully we do ok at the Nationals but even if we don't we have learnt lots and enjoyed playing the game.
