Principal's Report

Welcome to Week 4 Term 4. My goodness isn't the term moving quickly.

GRANDPARENTS DAY -We have many exciting activities on at Wollondilly this term. Last week we had an exciting day when we dressed up as our favourite book charter and invited the grandparents to our school. We had over 250 visitors to our school and had the most enjoyable time showing off our excellent reading skills to the grandparents. Thank you to the grandparents and special friends for coming to visit. Thank you to the teachers for the costumes and effort you went to ensuring the day was a success. <u>KINDERGARTEN ORIENTATION</u> -Kindergarten Orientation begins on 8 November. There will be another session on 22 November. While pre-schoolers are in the classroom, parents attend information sessions, we will buddy them up with their Year 6 leader for next year at these meetings. We look forward to welcoming our Kindergarten students for 2018! If you know of any students who are not yet enrolled for 2018 could you please ask their parents to contact the school.

<u>Classes for 2019</u>- At this point in the year we begin to consider class structures for the following year. I would like to ask parents who may be moving or taking an extended vacation at the beginning of next year, to please let us know in writing as soon as possible. This will allow us to either take your child's placement off the class lists for next year or keep them on while they are still on vacation. Also, if you have a particular request relating to next year, could you please put this in writing and forward it to me for consideration. We will do what we can to accommodate reasonable requests where they do not run at odds with broader educational factors.

SCHOOL LEADERSHIP- The process of electing our student leadership team for 2018 is about to begin. Information for parents has gone home about this important process.

HATS AND TERM 4 WEATHER -All families are reminded of our SunSmart policy where children are strongly encouraged to wear a broad brimmed hat whenever they are in the playground. This is so important in the Australian sun as our aim is to minimise over-exposure to UV radiation and reduce the risk of skin cancer. Students who do not wear a hat will be asked to sit or play a quiet game in the shade. Hats are available from the uniform shop.

SWIM SCHOOL SCHEME -The Swim School Scheme is a program provided for students to improve their swimming abilities and learn about Water Safety. Each day students will be provided with an informative presentation of how to be safe in a variety of water activities, including pools, rivers, beaches and other water areas. Students are then grouped according to their swimming ability ranging from 0m swim to 50m swim. They develop their swimming skills in a safe, encouraging and supportive environment and are assessed on their ability pre and post Swim School program. Water Safety is a life -saving life skill.

I encourage all students who are not able to swim or those who are not very strong swimmers to attend these sessions. Please note this is not a Swim Squad training program for swimming competitions. There are 3 sessions with a 60 student allocation per session.

The lessons will take place at Goulburn Swimming Pool. Permission notes have been sent home with eligible students. Allocation of available places will be given to first notes received.


From their research, they created a brochure or project explaining the important features, history and other interesting facts. They have produced fabulous brochures and projects!




