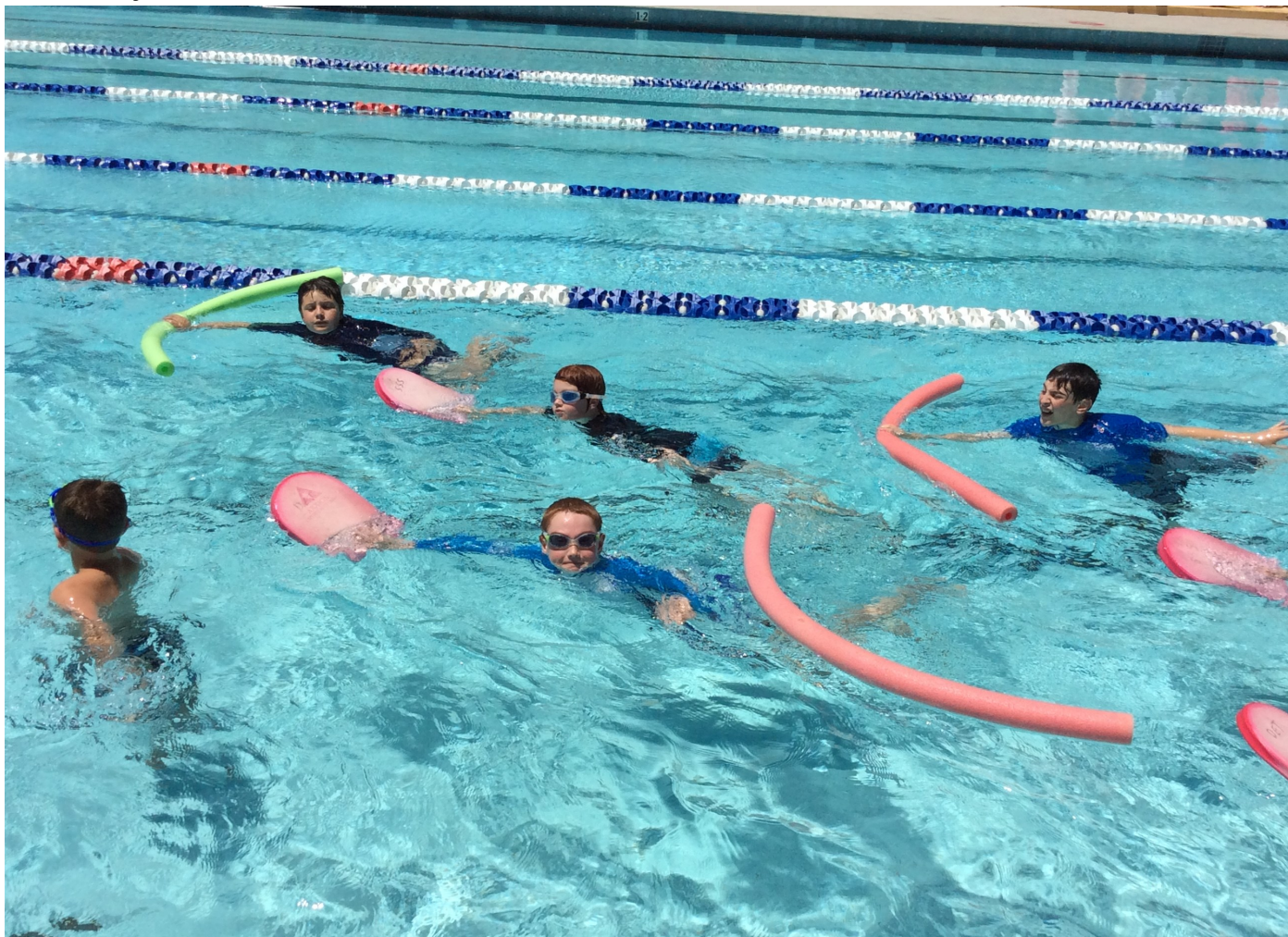

Dogs bark, they love to play,



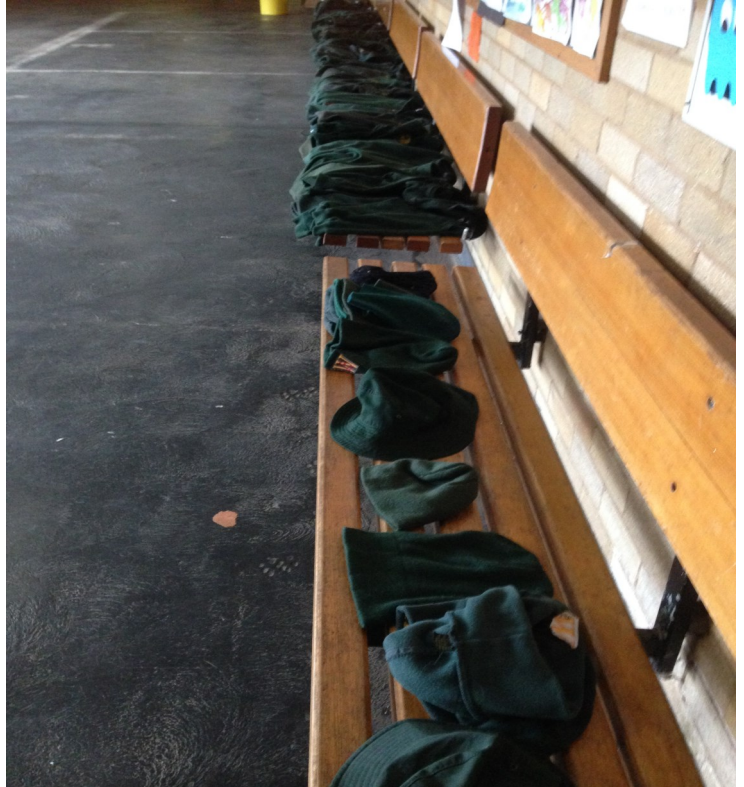
Lost Property

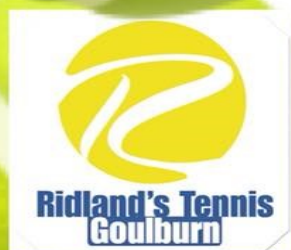
