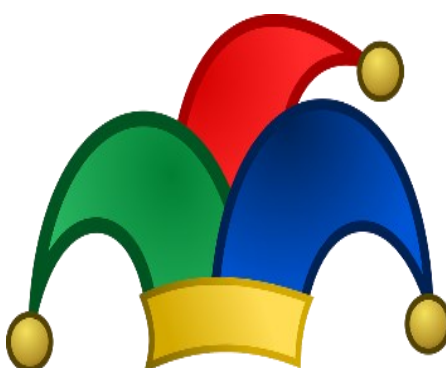
K-2 Percussion

Class 3-6D

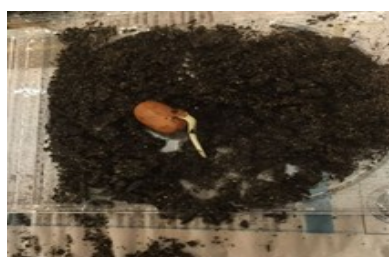
