School Plan 2018- 2020 I am very pleased with our current model and practice of self-assessment as we rigorously measure the progress and performance of our 2018-2020 School Plan. Our school teams are invested in gathering and tracking evidence and assessment data and collaboratively building analysis processes against the School Excellence Framework.
