WELLBEING ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL

The concept of wellbeing and its close links with learning are not new. A wealth of evidence is available to inform educators of this important relationship in the work they do every day, there is a heightened awareness of, and commitment to, personalised and differentiated learning and support for every student to succeed. Wellbeing, or the lack of it, can affect a student's engagement and success in learning.

With this information and knowledge we have appointed an Assistant Principal Wellbeing. This is Mr Scott Fagan. Mr Fagan was successful after a rigorous Expression Of Interest process. He will be responsible for the learning, engagement and wellbeing of our students so that each child is known, valued and cared for. Part of Mr Fagan's role is to communicate with parents about detentions and absences, student's wellbeing and engagement in the classroom. As we are a rapidly growing school, this part of our job in this area is also rapidly growing.

COMMUNICATION WITH THE COMMUNITY

Mr Fagan also is tasked with changing the way we communicate with our school community. We will be trialling text and/or email for detention notifications, newsletters and absences over the next few weeks so watch this space. You will be getting a letter from Mr Fagan today to inform you about this process and do update your details so we know who to send the information through to. We are hoping to reduce our environmental footprint and also allow processes in our school to be quick and easy.

LEARNING AND SUPPORT TEAM

The school learning and support team plays a key role in ensuring that the specific needs of students with disability and additional learning and support needs are met.

The team:

- supports teachers in identifying and responding to the additional learning needs of students
- facilitates and coordinates a whole school approach to improving the learning outcomes of every student
- coordinates planning processes and resourcing for students with disability and additional learning and support needs
- designs and implements the supports required to build teacher capacity so that all students access quality learning
- develops collaborative partnerships with the school, parents and carers, other professionals and the wider school community.

Every school has a Learning and Support Team. The composition of teams may vary as they are made up of members according to the needs of the particular school and community in which they work. Members of the Learning and Support Team: Principal, Assistant Principal Support, Assistant Principal Wellbeing, School Psychologist, Learning and Support Team Coordinator, Learning and Support Teacher.

Our school knows, values and cares for each and every student every day. As you can see we have many supports around our wonderful students so they can be successful learners and citizens. Have a wonderful fortnight.

The Story Behind 3-6L's Quilt

My Two Blankets is about a girl and her Auntie who were in a place where there was war. They moved away to a new place.

The girl felt different in the new place. People dressed differently, the food was different and people spoke differently. She didn't understand what people said.

She felt cold. She didn't feel safe. She described going out like standing under a cold waterfall. She felt alone and lost. She didn't know herself any more.

When she was at home she wrapped herself in an old blanket full of her own language and sounds. It felt warm and soft and safe.

She met a girl in a park who smiled at her and waved. The girl helped her learn new words, they played together, sometimes it made her laugh and sometimes she wanted to cry. She wanted to make friends but she didn't know how.

Slowly they learnt to talk to each other. She didn't feel like she was under a cold waterfall anymore. She started to make a new blanket and slowly it became warm and comfortable and she started to feel like herself again.

In 3-6L we studied My Two Blankets by Irena Kobald and Freya Blackwood. We talked about being ourselves and feeling safe. We talked about making friends. We had an idea. We each chose something we loved, we traced a picture and then we stitched over the picture. We put it together to make our own blanket to remind us what it means to feel safe and warm and to be ourselves!
