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**STUDENT VOICE** At Wollondilly Public School we are strengthening 'student voice'. We believe this is important because the research tells us that children and young people who participate in decision-making, have higher levels of wellbeing, feel personally empowered to make a difference and experience strengthened relationships with adults and peers. They get to have a real impact on their learning and their school community, and to see how decision-making and democratic values work in a safe, supportive environment. One example of the impact of student voice at Wollondilly is:

**STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL** -We have a strong Student Representative Council (SRC) with representation from every class in years K-6. These students are nominated by their peers and meet regularly to discuss key initiatives that will improve our school. Ideas are then brought to the SRC meetings for discussion from each class.

**BIKE SAFETY** -Parents are encouraged to remind their children about bike safety rules. The school has received reports of Wollondilly PS students riding in an unsafe manner to and from school. These reports include students riding without helmets, crossing roads without looking and wandering all over the road. Wollondilly PS values the safety of all students. We are keen to ensure all students travel to and from school safely.

**THE NATIONALLY CONSISTENT COLLECTION OF DATA ON SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH DISABILITY (NCCD)** -The Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD) takes place every year. The NCCD is a collection that counts:

- the number of school students receiving an adjustment or 'help' due to disability
- the level of adjustment they are receiving to access education on the same basis as other students. Students are counted in the NCCD if they receive ongoing adjustments at school due to disability. This 'help' allows them to access education on the same basis as a child without a disability. A student is counted in the NCCD if they receive reasonable adjustments at school due to disability. Each year, schools collect the following information about the student, including:
  - their year of schooling
  - the level of adjustment received
  - the broad type of disability.

All schools in Australia must collect information about students with a disability. Funding from the Australian Government for students with a disability is based on the NCCD through the student with disability loading.

**SEMESTER REPORTS** -Students in Years K—6 will be issued their semester progress reports on Friday 5 July 2019. Teachers examine a large range of material in order to assess and report on each child. Your child's report:

- Is written in easy to understand language.
- Provides information about your child's learning in each of the Key Learning Areas.
- Includes a teacher comment that clearly identifies areas of strength and areas for further development.
- Provides information about your child's social development and commitment to learning.

As this term comes to a close -A very special thank you to our teachers, support staff and office staff for continuing to provide rich learning experiences for our students. They really are a remarkable group of adults and our school is most fortunate that they choose to come here each day. Have a wonderful holiday with your families and we look forward to seeing you all next term. Remember students return on Tuesday 23 July 2019.

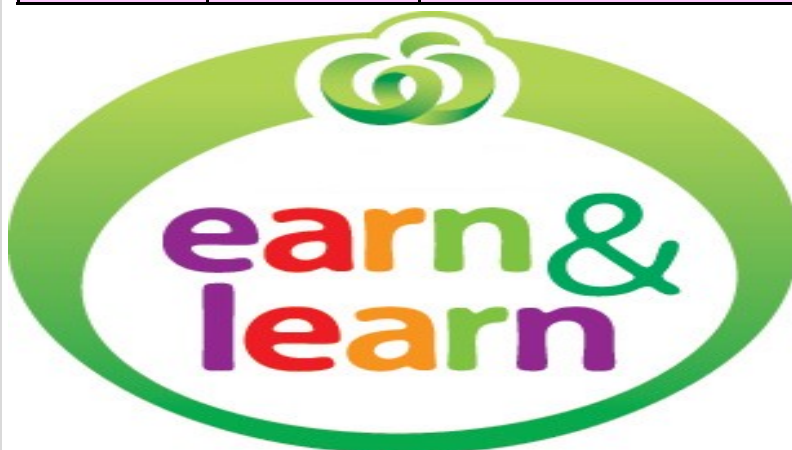

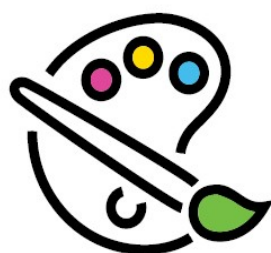
