

Principal's Report

NAPLAN- This week sees us receive our NAPLAN results, we have truly achieved great results. The growth in our students over all areas has been above state average. An example of this is in Spelling where the state average growth has been 83.2% and we have had a growth of 105.4%. Also in Writing the state had an average growth of 59.3% and we had a growth of 81.3%. Results like these are rare and this is absolutely due to our wonderful staff who reflect on their teaching craft and always are researching best practice and bring this knowledge to our classrooms each and every day. I would like to personally thank them for their collaborative and collective effort and to the students who have taken on feedback and have implemented that into their learning each day. Again congratulations to our whole community.

<u>EDUCATION WEEK OPEN DAY -</u> Thank you for your support last week as we celebrated Education Week with open classrooms and a sausage sizzle, together with our Father's Day stall. The positive feedback that I have been given has been tremendous. We are very proud of our school and to be recognised by you all is exactly what our vision is all about. We want Wollondilly to be the best school it can be with the most engaged children who feel they have active voices. Thank you to the staff for their support of this day and Miss Carroll for all of your organisation.

Music at Wollondilly

Wollondilly is very proud to offer so many Performing Arts opportunities to our students. Our concert coming up in Week 10 is one of the wonderful events our students can participate in. All students attend fortnightly music and dance lessons in the music room during their teacher's release time and their arts and drama lessons are taught by the classroom teachers.

The many benefits of music education include improved language and reading development, increased self-esteem and social skills. Beginning at an early age to develop beat and rhythm skills is a key factor in language development so we also run a preschool music session on Tuesday mornings at 9:15am in the music room. Any Goulburn families are welcome to attend.

Students from Year 1 to 6 learn recorder as one part of their music curriculum. Following our performance at the Opera House this year and the arrival of some Alto and Tenor recorders, many students are taking up the opportunity to gain extra practise time by attending the music room at Fruit Break each day.

We follow a recorder program called Black Belt Recorder and as student's skills increase they move from White belt up to Black Belt. With the recent arrival of our bigger recorders we have decided that students who reach Black Belt are allowed to try out these recorders and learn to play them if they wish. We have a large display in the music room where students can move their character along to show which belt level they are on. It has been very exciting to see so much movement up the chart in the past few weeks.

At Wollondilly all students have a labelled recorder to use in class time. Recorders are also available to purchase for \$10 from the music room if students wish to have one at home to work on their skills.

TIK TOK



Tik Tok is a social media platform for creating, sharing and discovering short music videos. Every day, millions of people use Tik Tok as an outlet to express themselves through singing, dancing, comedy, and lip-syncing. The app celebrates creativity with videos recorded in 15 seconds or less and shared across the Tik Tok community.

You have the ability to make cool, short videos-songs or short dialogues – that you can share with the world, and people can see them. Think MTV meets SNL meets karaoke meets Dubsmash meets American Idol meets Instagram.

Challenges

- 12+ content in the songs lyrics. Swearing and adult concepts in the provided music.
- Pornography, graphic content, suicide notes
- Tik Tok users can search for other users to view or follow near their own location/city.
- User generated videos can be viewed and shared onto other social media and messaging apps increasing exposure.
- Bullying in comments.
- Users can publicise their messenger usernames or social media profiles on their Tik Tok profile.
- Many fake user accounts, used to hijack views or set up to bully.
- Hacking of accounts by promotional accounts (Free Tik Tok Crowns) within the apps.
- Not easy to report accounts for being fakes or underage inside the app.
- Many underage accounts with large amounts of followers.
- Easy for users to create multiple accounts and hide them from their parents.
- Fake Tik Tok apps on the app store that charge for download or offer followers.

How Do I Delete My Tik Tok Account?

- Open the Tik Tok app and login.
- Tap on the person icon at the lower right of your screen to open your profile.
- Click on the three dots located in the upper right corner.
- Click on 'Privacy and Settings'.
- Click on 'Manage my Account'.

- Add a phone number if you haven't already.
- A verified phone number is a requirement for removing your Tik Tok account.
- O Scroll to the bottom of the page where it ays Thinking about removing your account?' Tap it.
- O Tap 'Send Code'.
- Wait for the code to be sent.
- O Enter the 4-digit code within 60 seconds of it being sent to you. Then hit continue.
- Read over the implications of removing your account. Hit continue if you agree with the terms.
- O Hit 'Delete Account'. You'll be logged out and your account will be deleted.

- Tap on the magnifying glass.
- 0 Search for the user you want to block,
- Tap their name or photo.
- O Tap on the ··· icon.
- Tap 'Block'.


